Meeting Date & Location

A RESOLUTION OF THE ASPEN TRAILS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT ESTABLISHING A TIME AND PLACE FOR REGULAR MEETINGS AND DESIGNATING PLACES FOR THE POSTING OF NOTICES OF REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, The Aspen Trails Metropolitan District is required by C.R.S. 32-1-904 to designate a time and place for regular meetings and to post notice of all regular and special meetings in at least three public places within the limits of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District is also required by the Colorado Sunshine Law, C.R.S. 24-6-402(2)(C) to designate annually at its first regular meeting of each calendar year the public places for posting of notice to the public of all meetings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ASPEN TRAILS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT:

1. That the Board of Directors of the Aspen Trails Metropolitan District shall hold regular meetings on the **1st Wednesday of every even month, at 6 o'clock pm. At 555 South Camino del Rio, Building A-4, Durango, Colorado.** Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called in accordance with the provisions of the Special District Act and shall be held at such times and such places as are designated in the notice of the special meeting.

2. Notice of all regular and special meetings shall be posted at the following three places within the limits of the District:

1. Aspen Trails Mailbox bulletin board
2. Black Dog Tavern bulletin board
3. Helen's Store bulletin board

A copy of the notice of time and place designated for all regular meetings shall be posted in the locations specified above and shall be posted in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of La Plata County, Colorado.

RESOLUTION 2004-3

A resolution to impose an operations and maintenance fee on all lots within the Aspen Trails Metropolitan District boundaries for ongoing operations and maintenance of the District.

Whereas, the Aspen Trails Metropolitan District is a Special District of the State of Colorado organized under the Special District Act CRS 32-1-101, et seq; and

Whereas, the District is authorized to provide road maintenance and improvement services, to serve property located within the District; and

Whereas, no property tax funding for the District will be received during the 2004 calendar year; and

Whereas, without initial funds to pay for operations and maintenance to support the District, there will be no funding for snow removal during the 2004-05 winter, there will be no drainage work, no funding for insurance and other administrative costs, such as auditing that are required by state law for Special Districts to comply with.

Now therefore, be it resolved, by the Board of Directors of the Aspen Trails Metropolitan District, La Plata County, Colorado:

1. **Operations and Maintenance Fee:** There is hereby imposed a fee known as an operations and maintenance assessment in the amount of \$200 per lot. One fee shall be assessed against each platted lot located within the boundaries of the District, including lots which may be added to the District through boundary adjustments during the year 2004.
2. **Use of Funds.** Funds received shall be used for the start-up and ongoing operations and maintenance of the District.
3. **Payment.** The operations and maintenance assessment may be paid in full on or before October 31, 2004. Alternatively, owners may pay the fee in monthly installments of at least \$25. The first installment must be received by March 31, 2004, the final installment due by October 31, 2004.
4. **Delinquencies.** If payment is not received pursuant to Section 3, a late fee of \$10 per lot, per month, will be charged for each operations and maintenance assessment which is delinquent for 30 days or more. Any account which is sixty days delinquent will be subject to the filing of a lien. Accounts which are ninety days delinquent shall be subject to lien foreclosure and all other collection remedies available to the District.
5. **Effective Date.** The provisions of this Resolution shall take affect upon adoption.
